

Initial setup and driving should be done in an open area free of obstacles until the user is fully capable of operating the product safely. Intended Use 7.1

The **Thin Articulating Lateral** is intended for use as a low-profile, adjustable thoracic support attachment for both manual and power wheelchairs. The lateral's thin, lightweight design allows it to be used in limited-space scenarios unsuited for standard lateral support solutions.

A spring-loaded quick-release push latch allows the **Thin Articulating Lateral** to be swung 125° away from the user for easy care and transfer, while each joint of the lateral arm offers 200° of adjustability. Offered in both one- and two-point adjustment models, the lateral accommodates track, cane, planar, Tru Comfort, and All Seasons mounting options.

Fully customizable pads attach easily to the lateral, while slip covers conceal hardware and provide soft, smooth points of contact for users.

The Thin Articulating Lateral features:

- a discreet, unobstructive design;
- one- and two-point adjustment configurations;
- 200° of adjustment at each point;
- multiple mounting styles and options;
- a quick-release lateral swing away latch; and
- soft, unabrasive hardware covers







Preparations 10.1

Only a qualified service technician may install the TFB back and its accessories.

A WARNING

Incorrectly installing a **Thin Articulating Lateral** and/or its accessories may damage the hardware and/or injure the user.

Tools 10.2

Use the proper tools to install and adjust the lateral(s) to the desired position(s) for the user. Ensure all torque specifications are followed.

CAUTION

The use of improper tools may cause damage to the device. Not tightening to the torque specification can cause components to fail or cause discomfort to the user.

Installation Plan 10.3

Set up an installation plan before beginning the installation. This plan should take into account:


- where the lateral(s) will be placed;
- how the laterals will function; and
- the space needed for sufficient clearance of other hardware and accessories.


CAUTION

Any connection must always be secured with all delivered screws. Only use the screws provided in the package.

Required Tools 10.4

The tools needed to complete the installation are as follows:





Step One: Identify the male cane clamp and the female cane clamp.


Step Two: Attach the lateral's latch block to the female cane clamp by inserting the two $(2) 1/4-20 \times 3/8$ " button head screws through the face of the latch block and into the female cane clamp, as pictured above.

Step Three: Attach the male tube clamp to the female clamp by, from the opposite side of the wheelchair cane, inserting the two (2) $1/4-20 \times 3/4$ " socket head screws through the male clamp into the interior of the female clamp.

Standard Track Mounting

10.6

(Note: The SSTLTA-TB4 assembly is not compatible with standard track mounting.)




Step One: Loosely attach the track nut to the lateral latch block by inserting the two (2) socket head screws provided through the face of the latch block and into the track nut, as pictured above.

Step Two: Slide the track nut into the corresponding groove in the track mount. Tighten the screws to secure the assembly position.

Standard Planar Mounting

Step One: Attach the planar mount to the lateral latch block by inserting the two (2) $1/4-20 \times 3/4$ " socket head screws through the face of the latch block and into the planar mount. (The planar mount and the lateral latch block be joined at a 90° angle.)

Step Two: Attach the assembly to the chair by inserting the two (2) $1/4-20 \times 3/8$ " button head screws through the planar mount tracks and into the chair back mounting hardware.

First-Time Use 11.0

Dealer Assistance 11.1

During first-time use by the client, it is advised that the dealer or service technician not only assembles the product, but also explains the configuration of user positioning to the customer (i.e., the user and/or the attendant). If needed, the dealer can make final adjustments.

User Testing 11.2

It is important that the customer is fully aware of the installation of a **Thin Articulating Lateral**, how to use it, and how it can be adjusted to fit the client comfortably. As a dealer, proceed as follows:

• Explain and show the customer how you have executed the installation and explain the function.

Have the user test the position of the lateral:

- Is the hardware in the proper position for the client?
- Can the user safely operate all controls with minimal effort?

If needed, make any adjustments to the positioning.

Explain possible problems and how to address them to the customer.

Conditions of Use 11.3

Thin Articulating Laterals are intended for use as installed by the dealer, in accordance to the installation instructions in this manual.

- The foreseen conditions of use are communicated by the dealer or service technician to the user and/or attendant during the first-time use.
- If the usage conditions change significantly, please contact your dealer or a qualified service technician to avoid unintended damage.

Maintenance 12.0

Cleaning 12.1

- Use a soft cloth to clean the lateral.
- Ensure all cleaners are approved for finished steel, aluminum, plastic, and upholstered surfaces
- Hand wash foam pad cover with mild, soapy water or detergent, and let dry.
- Use a soft brush to remove dirt and debris in the zipper teeth.

To wash the covers of the laterals:

- Remove the pad/cover from the laterals.
- Machine wash in cold water on delicate cycle and drip dry.

Fabric care instructions can be found on the covers of the cushions and back:

- Remove the pad/cover from the laterals.
- Machine wash in cold water on delicate cycle and drip dry.



Do not bleach.

Do not iron.

Do not hand wash in water temperatures above 160°F (70°C).

Do not wash or machine dry.

!CAUTION

Take care when removing the back as to not puncture, tear, or otherwise damage the fabric or foam.

ACAUTION

Take care when zipping and unzipping the cover to ensure nothing gets caught in the zipper path.

Disinfecting 12.2

- Wipe gently with a cloth dampened with a household disinfectant.
- Allow foam to air dry thoroughly.

WARNING Do not immerse foam in water.

Maintenance 12.0

Maintenance 12.3

These care and guideline instructions will keep the hardware and covers in good condition for a longer period of time and prevent damage:

- Check and re-tighten all fasteners to the proper torque specifications on a regular basis.
- Check pads and covers for any breakdown.
- Repair or replace parts as needed.
- Gently remove dust and dirt from hardware with a damp cloth.

ACAUTION

Always check all mounting hardware, making sure each fastener is properly tightened before using the back support.

SAFETY

Replace or repair parts as needed.
