

Intended Use

The True Forming Back, or TFB, has been created to provide extreme comfort, unparalleled customization options and trouble-free adjustability. The hardware is durable, easily accessible, and is hidden with a hook-and-loop attached back for a clean, sleek look.

The rigid aluminum shell, coupled with a double layer of soft, supportive foam and supple cover material, provides an optimal surface to match the contours of the user's back and upper torso. This helps to maintain proper positioning of the pelvis, back and torso.

Features

The TFB features:

- · Depth and width adjustments;
- Angle adjustment without loss of seat depth;
- Push-button swing-away laterals assist with transfers from the chair;
- · Smooth, finished edging on all parts; and,
- · Full adjustability to meet the needs of almost any client.

Mounting

The TFB mounting hardware can be installed on almost any chair that utilizes canes or tubes. The TFB seat back is designed to be removable and provides additional width, angle and depth adjustments as needed. The TFB can accommodate many types of positioning belt systems and multiple headrests including the TWB480 and HMO series. It works with J&L, 2-Point Quick Release, All-Purpose Adjustable Knob, or Trouble Free mounting hardware. Two- and four-wing lateral configurations are also supported.

SAFETY

Always check all mounting hardware, making sure each fastener is properly tightened before using the back support.

Altering a back in any way and/or improper installation will void the warranty.

Parts and Accessories Breakdown

A typical TFB package will contain the following items:

1. Back

Composed of a rigid aluminum shell (Linear, Contour or Flex models) with a dual layer of soft, supportive foam and a supple cover material of Neoprene, Airmesh or Coolcore®. A Foam-in-Place option is also available.

2. Mounting Hardware

Either J&L, Quick Release, All Purpose Adjustable Knob or Trouble Free mounting kit to fasten the back to the back posts (canes).

3. Lateral Wings

One or two pairs of lateral wings are included in the kit. Wings are installed on the sides of the shell and provide thoracic support. Wings are articulated or swing-away type, which allows easier transfers to and from the chair.





TFB Backrest & Lateral



Preparations

Only a qualified service technician may install the TFB back and its accessories.



An incorrect installation of the TFB and its accessories may cause damage to the hardware and/or injury to the user.

Tools

Use the proper tools to install and adjust the TFB to the desired position for the user.



The use of improper tools may cause damage to the device. Any connection must always be secured with all delivered screws. Use only the screws included in the package.

Installation Plan

Set up an installation plan before beginning the installation. This plan should take into account:

- Where the TFB will be placed as well as applicable laterals and support cushions:
- How the TFB will be operated the quick release functions for the mount and laterals; and,
- Allowing sufficient clearance for other hardware and accessories.

Required Tools

The tools needed to complete the lateral installation are as follows:



Hardware	Description
5/32"Hex Key	Lateral Mounting
1/8" Hex Key	Lateral Cushion Mount; Socket Head Screw on Lateral
4mm Hex Key	Button Head Screws on Lateral Bracket

Tools are not provided. Refer to the manuals included with any additional accessories for the additional tools required for their installation.

Installing the Laterals

Step One: Place the lateral track nut (A) into the groove of the 125° lateral

bracket (B).

Step Two: Slide the 125° lateral bracket (B) between the aluminum shell (C) and


covered foam back (D). After having the bracket in the correct position, use the two M6x1x12mm button head cap screws (E1), each with a 1/4" washer (E2), to secure the bracket in place. The depth that the bracket is placed can be adjusted to change the horizontal placement of the lateral to the appropriate position for the user. The vertical alignment of the bracket can be adjusted anywhere along

the back rest track.

Step Three: Use the two 1/4-20x3/8" button head screws (F) to secure the lateral

(G) to the bracket.

Step Four: Repeat steps 1-3 to mount each additional lateral.



Installing the Cushion to the Laterals

Step One:


Slide the cushion (A) onto the lateral (B) using the flap on the back of the cushion cover. Align the holes on the curved metal plate of the cushion with the track on the lateral pad mount. The position of the cushion can be adjusted by aligning it anywhere on the lateral track.

Step Two:

With the cushion in the correct place, use the two #10-32x5/8" button head cap screws (C), each with a #10 external tooth lock washer (D) to secure the cushion in place.


Step Three:


Repeat steps 1-2, to mount each additional cushion to each additional lateral.



Lateral Adjustment

To adjust the angle of the Lateral hardware, use a 1/8" T-Handle on the $10-32 \times 3/8$ " Socket Head Screw (E). Loosen the screw, adjust to the optimal position for the user and tighten securely to lock in place.





Dealer Assistance

During first time use by the client, it is advised that the dealer or service technician assists and explains the set-up to the customer (the user and/or the attendant). If needed, the dealer may make final adjustments.

User Testing

It is important that the customer is fully aware of the installation, how to use it, and what can be adjusted in order to gain as much mobility as possible. As a dealer, proceed as follows:

 Explain and show the customer how you have executed the installation, and explain the function.

Have the user test the position of the TFB:

- Is the hardware in the proper position for the client?
- Can the user safely operate all controls with minimal effort?

If needed, make any adjustments to the positioning. Explain to the customer possible problems and how to address them.

Conditions of Use

The TFB is intended for use as installed by the dealer, in accordance with the installation instructions in this manual.

- The foreseen conditions of use are communicated by the dealer or service technician to the user and/or attendant during the first time use.
- If the usage conditions change significantly, please contact your dealer or a qualified service technician to avoid excessive wear and tear or unintended damage.

Maintenance

Cleaning

- Use a soft cloth to clean the back shell.
- Ensure all cleaners are approved for finished steel, aluminum, plastic, and upholstered surfaces.
- Hand wash the foam pad cover with mild, soapy water or detergent, rinse well, and let dry.
- Foam pad should NOT get wet.
- A brush with soap and water can be used to remove any dirt and debris that may become lodged in the zipper teeth.



DO NOT immerse foam in water.

DO NOT Bleach. DO NOT tumble dry. DO NOT Iron.

DO NOT hand wash in water temperatures above 160°F (70°C).

To wash the covers of the laterals:

- Remove the pad/cover from the lateral; and,
- Machine wash in cold water on delicate cycle and drip dry.

Fabric care instructions can be found on the covers on the cushions and back.



Exercise caution when removing the back to avoid punctures, tears, or other damage to the fabric or foam.

Be careful not to catch hair, wires or other items when zipping and unzipping the covers.

Disinfection

- Wipe gently with a cloth dampened with a household disinfectant.
- Allow foam to air dry thoroughly.

Maintenance

These care and guideline instructions will keep the hardware and covers in good condition for a longer period of time and prevent damage.

- Check and tighten all fasteners on a regular basis. Do not overtighten the fasteners.
- Check pad/covers for any breakdown.
- Repair or replace parts as needed.
- Gently remove dust and dirt from hardware with a damp cloth as necessary.
