Testing

Initial setup and driving should be done in an open area free of obstacles until the user is fully capable of driving safely.

Intended Use

Stealth Products wheelchair accessories include handrims, wheels, and tires. These provide the user with upper limb mobility the ability to propel and maneuver the wheelchair.

Wheel

Wheelchair rear wheels consist of the tire, rim (and handrim on manual chairs), spokes (or mags), and a hub. The hub is the center of the wheel, the spokes (or mags) connect the rim to the hub, and the rim is where the tire is mounted.

Handrim

The handrim is the outer circular component of the maneuvering wheel intended to give a user with upper limb mobility the ability to propel and maneuver a manual wheelchair.

Tire

We offer solid tires that provide the best shock absorption and flat-free ride possible, with traction that rivals pneumatic tires. Non-marking tread ensures minimal floor damage. Tires are delivered unmounted from the wheel and will appear too small to fit when received. Tires will need to be stretched prior to installation.

Handrims

NOTICE

Before use, it is important that you check the handrims for any damage. Always keep both hands on the handrim as you go over an obstacle.

Standard six tab anodized aluminum.

Handrims are used for propelling the manual wheelchair using the hands and upper body. Available in three sizes.

Tires

We offer high pressure solid tires in three different sizes that are ideal for everyday use and can be used on a variety of surfaces and terrain.

SHOX Solid Wheelchair Tires are 110 psi equivalent.

Replacement of solid tires requires specialized equipment. If your solid tires need replacement, you must have this done by an authorized dealer or qualified technician. If you ignore this warning, you may seriously injure yourself or others, or damage the wheelchair.

Wheels

Direct Mount Wheels

- 1. To remove the direct mount wheel(s), unscrew the lock nut (3/4-16 LLN or 1/2" LN) with an adjustable wrench.
- 2. To install a new wheel, screw on the lock nut (3/4-16 LLN or 1/2" LN).

Quick Release Axle Pin for Wheels

(A quick release wheelchair wheel axle allows for fast and easy removal of 1/2" diameter quick release wheelchair axle pins.

- 1. To remove the axle pin, push in the quick release wheelchair axle pin head (ADI logo) and then pull the pin out towards your body to remove.
- 2. To install a new wheel, place wheel hub into axle and install the quick release axle pin into the hub until you hear a clicking sound. Note: if the axle pin doesn't click, rotate the pin until it clicks. If it still doesn't click you need to loosen the nut on the axle pin.

Handrim

1. Tools and Hardware Needed

Phillips #2 screwdriver 3/8" Combination wrench (6) - 10/32 thread, 7/16" long (6) - 10/32 thin nylon-insert lock nut

2. Remove the old Handrim

Remove the screws that mount the handrim to the wheel using the Phillips screwdriver.

2. Install the new Handrim

If needed, bend the tabs slowly in to line up to the wheel holes.

Ensure that the handrim is being installed on the outside of the wheel (the side where the wheel push-pin is located).

Install the screw on the outside of the wheel and the lock nut on the inside of the wheel, tightening the screws in a criss-cross pattern.









Dealer Assistance

During first time use by the client, it is advised that the dealer or service technician assists and explains the configurations to the customer (the user and/or the attendant). If needed, the dealer can make final adjustments.

User Testing

It is important that the customer is fully aware of the installation, how to use it, and what can be adjusted in order to gain as much mobility as possible. As a dealer, proceed as follows:

• Explain and show the customer how you have executed the installation, and explain the function of every item.

Have the user test the wheel, tire and/or handrim:

- Is the hardware in the proper position for the client?
- Can the user safely operate the wheelchair with minimal effort?
- Is the placement in an optimal position for the user?

If needed, adjust the wheel, tire and/or handrim to the proper position.

Explain possible problems to the customer and address solutions to those problems.

Conditions of Use

The wheels, tires and handrims are intended for use as installed by the dealer, in accordance with the installation instructions contained in this manual.

- The foreseen conditions of use are communicated by the dealer or service technician to the user and/or attendant during first time use.
- If the usage conditions change significantly, please contact your dealer or qualified service technician to avoid excessive wear and tear or unintended damage.,

General Information

Maintenance

After making any adjustments or repairs to your wheelchair and after any servicing of your wheelchair, always make sure all attachment hardware is tightened securely before using the chair. If you ignore this warning, you may fall, tip over, or lose control of your wheelchair and seriously injure yourself or others or damage the wheelchair.

If any of the following conditions are found, please contact your dealer.

Inspect Rear Wheels - Weekly

- Inspect for cracked, bent, or broken spokes
- Make sure all spokes are uniformly tight
- Inspect hubs and rims for cracks and wear
- Inspect for "trueness" (excessive side movement when wheel is lifted and spun indicates lack of "trueness".)

Inspect Handrim - Monthly

- Inspect for signs of rough edges or peeling
- · Make sure handrims are securly attached to the rim

Inspect Tires - Weekly

• Inspect for cracks, wear, and flat spots.

NOTICE

Do not use WD-40[®], 3-in-1 Oil[®], or other penetrating lubricants on quick release or quad release axles. Instead, **ALWAYS** use either a dry Teflon[®]-based lubricant or a dry silicone spray as a lubricant.
