#### **Design and Function**

### **Intended Use**

The Tone Deflector was specifically designed to address the issue of rearward forces and impact shocks exerted on headrests by clients with high tone. The Tone Deflector absorbs shock and provides a degree of deflection at the junction of the headrest hardware and the pad. It mechanically damps rearward forces, reduces the force of quick impact loading, and diverts angular forces by up to 10° in any direction. This can help clients manage tone, while reducing the frequency of headrest hardware adjustments for clinicians.

### **Features**


- Absorbs high tone rearward and angular forces.
- Moves with the client to absorb high tone actions.
- Helps with quick impact loading.
- Averts slanted angle loading up to 10° in any direction.
- Available in two models, to fit 1 inch and 17mm ball mount Stealth headrests, including the Ultra, i2i, Combo, All Positioning, and Comfort Plus.

## Mounting

The Tone Deflector is designed to be mounted onto **Stealth Products'** headrests to absorb high tone forces. It is not recommended to be used in conjunction with **Stealth Products'** i-Drive interface or the HMO500 hardware.



### **Installation Plan**


Set up an installation plan before mounting the Tone Deflector to the headrest. After installation, ensure that the Tone Deflector is mounted properly and that all screws are tightened evenly.



Ensure that split rings remain in alignment with mounting surfaces during the tightening process. Uneven or excess tightening can cause stripped threads, misaligned or bent rings, and other damage to mounting parts.

### Installing the Tone Deflector to the Headrest


The following instructions cover both models of the Tone Deflector hardware. The illustrations show TD100 (4-hole for 17mm) mounted to an i2i headrest, but are applicable to the TD101 (3-hole for 1 in.) as well as other headrest models.




**Step 2:** Insert and thread the four (4) M5x0.8x10mm Socket Head Screws\* (D1) through the interface plate and into the holes in the mounting plate of the headrest. Tighten evenly with a hex key.




Ensure the Tone Deflector Interface Plate is mounted level on the headrest. Improper mounting of the plate can cause improper function or failure of the Tone Deflector.




**Step 4:** Place the Tone Deflector Interface Ring (A) over the Cylindrical Rubber Mount (B,C) and align the holes.



### Mounting the Headrest Hardware





**Step 3:** After the screws are tightened and the hardware has been properly installed, the Tone Deflector and headrest are now ready for installation onto the headrest hardware and chair.

### **Dealer Assistance**

During first-time use by the user, it is advised that the dealer or service technician not only assembles the product, but also explains the configuration of user positioning to the user (i.e., the user and or the attendant). If needed, the dealer can make final adjustments.

### **User Testing**

It is important that the customer is fully aware of the installation of the **Tone Deflector**, how to use it, and how it can be adjusted to fit the client comfortably. As a dealer, proceed as follows:

- Explain and show the customer how you have executed the installation and explain the function.
- Have the user test the position of the Tone Deflector.
- Is the hardware in the proper position for the client?
- Can all controls be operated safely and with minimal effort?
- If needed, make any adjustments to the positioning.
- Explain possible problems to the customer and how to address them.

#### Conditions of Use

The **Tone Deflector** is intended for use as installed by the dealer, in accordance to the installation instructions in this manual.

Ensure the foreseen conditions of use are communicated by the dealer or service technician to the user and/or attendant during the first-time use.

If usage conditions change significantly, please contact your dealer or a qualified service technician to avoid unintended damage.

### **Cleaning**

Your **Tone Deflector** hardware should not require cleaning other than wiping its surface periodically with a soft cloth and a cleaning solution approved for painted or anodized aluminum surfaces.



Do not use petroleum based cleaners or chemicals to clean the **Tone Deflector**, as degradation of rubber components may occur and lead to reduced function or failure of the device.



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
